

ROCK STAR rules & Expectations

BEFORE & AFTER SCHOOL

Students should not arrive at school before 7:40a.m. Doors will remain locked until this time. Students will be dismissed at 3:05.

RULES

My students will be expected to follow the rules of the classroom and school each and every day. Expectations are posted below, in our classroom and all over the school. Examples of each are also posted. I know that all of my little rock stars are capable of following these rules!

- * Be responsible.

DISCIPLINE

Summersville Grade School has a school-wide behavior system called PAWS (Positive Attitudes, Wonderful Students). Please see attached letter for more detailed information. When a student loses a PAW there will be a consequence for the student. These consequences are normally loss of privileges such as free time, group play during recess (students will have the opportunity to be active, but not with the rest of the group), or other group activities/privileges.

INDIVIDUAL REWARDS

Students will be rewarded for their good behavior. Our school is implementing the PAWS (Positive Attitudes, Wonderful Students) program this year. Please see attached letter for more information. In my classroom, I also use a punch card system to individually reward good behavior. Student will have the opportunity to earn hole punches on a punch card for good choices. Punches can be earned for good behavior in my classroom and anywhere else in the school. Once the punch card is full (20 punches) your child will get to pick from the Punch Card Reward Book. I love celebrating the good choices my students make! ☺

CLASS REWARDS

As a class, we will also work together this year to earn special parties and/or privileges this year. We will make a goal together for good behavior. When we meet our goal, we will celebrate!

HOMEWORK POLICY

At the beginning of each week, I will send home an assignment sheet that will have all of our weekly assignments. Assignments will also be posted on the class website. Students will have reading, math and spelling homework most every night and a Friday journal (homework for you ☺). Occasionally we might have other assignments. All of the homework that students are assigned must be completed and returned the next day. There will be consequences for homework that is not completed or returned. Students will have to sit during recess and/or other privileges so that he or she can complete the homework assignment(s).

CONSEQUENCES FOR HOMEWORK MISSED ARE:

- 1st incident (for individual subjects)- noon detention
- 2nd - noon detention
- 3rd - after school detention
- 4th - after school detention
- 5th - office referral and in-school suspension

TOYS

Students are not allowed to bring toys to school. If a toy is brought to school it must remain in the student's backpack. If the toy is taken out of the backpack, I will have to take it away. The first time I will give the toy back at the end of the day. If a toy is taken out during school time again, I will take the toy and keep it until the end of the week. Please encourage your children to leave toys at home. This includes electronic devices.

BirthDays

In an effort to keep things equal and fair, we do not celebrate birthdays with outside treats. I will provide the birthday student with a small treat and he/she gets to be the student of the day. Please do not send any treats or presents to school- they will be sent back home. **Birthday party invitations may only be distributed at school if everyone in the class is invited.** Summer birthdays are celebrated during the last week of school.

Water Bottles

Students are allowed to bring their own water bottles to school. I ask that you please send a reusable water bottle (environmentally responsible☺), with a lid that is easy for your child to open and close. Students may take the bottle home each evening or at the end of each week- that is completely up to you and your child. Students may refill their water bottles in the water fountain at certain times of the day. Since students will be keeping these at their desk, please be sure that the bottle does not leak or spill if tipped over. Water bottles are a privilege, and if a student does not act responsibly, it will be sent home.

You can keep up with the happenings of our classroom online! I will post important dates, events, and pictures on our website. I will never post a child's full name and picture together to protect my students' privacy.
